Courses

GRMN 1001. Elementary German I. 3-0-3 Units.

Provides an introduction to the German language and the culture of the German-speaking world. Beginning of a survey of basic German grammar and the development of the four language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing German. Some aspects of everyday life in the German-speaking world will also be introduced.

GRMN 1002. Elementary German II. 3-0-3 Units.

Provides the second part of an introduction to the German language and the culture of the German-speaking world. Completion of the survey of basic German grammar and further development of the four language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing German. Aspects of everyday life in the German-speaking world will also be introduced.

Prerequisites: GRMN 1001.
